This Week's Sunday School Activities – Coming Through the Holy Places

Sometimes a place feels holy because of rich cultural history or it is built and adorned to inspire praise. But can people make places feel holy just by offering simple kindness? This week we see that it is often the people in a place that inspires it with holiness when they speak the truth in love.

1) The focus Bible Reading this week is Mark 1: 21-28, Jesus shows up in a surprising way- as a teacher with a difference

Questions to think about after reading this Bible passage:

- a) What amazed the people who were in the synagogue to hear Jesus teach?
- b) In what ways might the man's life have been different after his experience with Jesus? c) What emotions do you think the one who was healed experienced? d) What have you learned about power and authority from this story about Jesus' ministry? e) What might we tell others about Jesus' powerful love?

Additional Scripture readings: Deuteronomy 18: 15-20, Psalm 111, 1 Corinthians 8: 1-13

Prophecy, blessings, conversions and teaching can occur on street corners, prisons and disadvantaged areas just as often as they occur in synagogues, temples and chapels. Epiphany is not always a matter of where we encounter God; it maybe a question of who journeys with us as we come through the holy places. Which begs the question, how are we a part of the holy places? Do we carry them within ourselves? What if the holiest places are not a church or a cathedral but carried in our heart and minds?

2) Prayer: God of hearts and homes, be with us so we may know the holiness of each person and place we encounter. Amen.
