Sunday School

This Week's Sunday School Activities - Choose to Give Thanks

This week's readings are all about making choices. The wilderness wanderers choose to complain against God. A psalmist writes of God's response to their prayers and the people choose to give God thanks. A letter to the church in Ephesus reminds us that we can choose to respond to God's grace by doing good in the world. The gospel of John tells us that God chooses to love the whole world and promises life.

1) The focus Bible Reading this week is Psalm 107: 1-3, 17-22. It begins with people choosing to give thanks because God has saved them. After this initial introduction, the psalm follows a distinctive pattern. The people first describe an issue or trouble, then pray to God to save them. They then describe God's saving actions and end with thanks for God's love.

Questions to consider about after reading this Bible passage a) How does God respond to those who cry out for help? (vs 19-20) b) What four different groups of people are mentioned? c) What else might these people be saying as they think about how much God loves them? d) What would you like to give thanks for? What could you tell the world about God's love?

Additional Scripture Readings: Numbers 21: 4-9, Ephesians 2: 1-10, John 3: 14-21

God hears our cries of distress, outpours love and then invites us to respond. How will we respond to God's love and grace in this Lenten season? In what ways can we choose to give thanks?

2) Prayer: Ever present God, we choose to give thanks for your presence in our lives. You shower us with extravagant love and invite us to respond with our love, thanks and praise. Your love and grace inspire us to act justly in the world. Help us to choose to trust in your protection and your love for us all. Amen

Note from Finance Committee

So far during the restrictions of 2020 and 2021 to date, we have met our obligations to operate the church while closed for normal activities using your weekly gifts, Willow Tree School rental fees, and reserves.

As we enter into the second year of Covid restrictions, we thought it is important to advise all our church family of our financial year to date position for 2021.

Here is our current 2021 Budget position:

Revenue will be our focus for all of 2021. We believe we can keep expenses "tight" and at or below budget forecasts.

The immediate concern is in our total envelope givings. To date, we are behind budget by \$10,345 or -31.4%. Keeping up with weekly contributions can be difficult during these unusual times, but we have ways to accept your contributions through etransfer, mail, envelope drop-off, or setting a PAR account.

Several PAR contributors have increased their monthly givings already, which is much appreciated. It is hoped all members who contribute through other means can find a way to bring offerings up to date or assist by increasing their monthly givings to keep the church in the best financial position when we come out of Covid restrictions.
