Sunday School

This Week's Sunday School Activities - Love Is a Verb

Power, name, love. These words weave through this week's texts and their interrelationship presents a rich depiction of the saving work of the divine amongst us. The name of Jesus Christ holds power. The power of Jesus resides in love. The love of God through Jesus exerts influence in us and over us. Our call is to love, to exercise our power in acts of love towards one another. The web continues to interweave and strengthen.

1) The focus Bible Reading this week is John 10: 11-18. This passage has a familiar comforting message. It is one of love and it shows how a good shepherd's love for his sheep is never ending, just like the love of Jesus for his people.

Questions to consider after reading this Bible passage.

a) What does Jesus say about what it means to be a "shepherd of the people"? b) What were some of the things that Jesus did to look after people? c) What are some ways that Jesus shared God's love with others? d) Who has been like a good shepherd for you? What did he or she do? e) What are some ways that we can show God's love to our family, to our friends and when we are at school?

Additional Scripture: Acts 4: 5-12, Psalm 23 and 1 John 3: 16-24

Contrary to the power exerted by human structures, the power of the resurrected Jesus Christ resides in his saving love for humanity. The power of this love gives us courage to show love to people in our lives. How can we individually and communally, enact our love in service to those who have often been excluded or oppressed?

2) Prayer: God of Love. We turn ourselves this day to the Good Shepherd as our inspiration and model for the sacrificial love for one another to which you have called us. Fill us with the power of your name and embolden us in our acts of love. Amen
