### This Week's Sunday School Activities

This week's Bible reading: 1 Corinthians 13: 1-7

Sharing Together- Talk about a time when the words someone spoke made you feel loved and accepted or gave you encouragement and hope. Create a list of words and phrases and share with your family as many as you can that express kindness. Put them away in a special place where you can go back and read them when you want.

b) List some things that the Bible reading tells you about love.

c) Select one or two of these things (or more) and write down how you can show in your life what they mean.

Consider this - Think about the words that you choose to use each day. Do they encourage or discourage? Do they build someone up or tear someone down? Do they comfort or hurt? Do they draw people together or push them apart? Stop and think before you speak. You may even want to pray before you say anything. The words that you choose to say each day cannot be taken back.

Prayer - Lord, help me to be kind and thoughtful to others wherever I might be, each and every day. Amen.
