This week's Bible Reading Psalm 96: 1-9.

Questions to consider after reading this Bible passage.

a) What does this passage say to you? b) In what ways can you worship the Lord? c) What song would you sing to the Lord?

A Story - Rick's family has a small cabin on a beautiful lake not too far from his home. His mother and father have been taking him there since he was a baby.
