We are all looking forward in returning for "live" services hopefully sometime in September, providing it is "safe" to do so.

But, we have a challenge...

To work towards a "zero" deficit position while being challenged by a change in Ministerial and Musical Leadership.

The above chart is the Actual revenue vs. Budget as of July 31st. All the bills are paid as of this date. We can keep expenses within budget estimates for day to day expenses, but we could be faced with additional ministerial expenses and possible expenses for musical leadership. While we have received Emergency Wage Subsidies in the past, this program ends in September and the amounts we receive have gone from \$3,000/month to under \$1,000/month

Our challenge is to improve our revenue intake to meet these expected new expenses over the next number of months. Meeting the revenue budget is a key issue for our church. You can contribute via <u>Direct</u> <u>deposit to our bank account via email</u> or mailing/leaving cheques in our new secure mailbox at the office door.

We have collectively met our revenue challenges in the past and it is hoped with these pending changes, we will do so again.
