Sunday School

This Week's Sunday School Activities - A New Way

God both comforts us and invites us out of our comfort zones. To be close to God is to recognize that He calls us to serve others and to extend ourselves beyond our own desires. To be close to God is to recognize the majesty and wonder of His creation and to be humbled by His glory.

1) The focus Bible Reading this week is Mark 10: 35-45. After following Jesus on the road to Jerusalem, the disciples decide that they want to remain close to him. However, in the same way that they misunderstand what awaits Jesus in Jerusalem (Mark 10: 32), this makes their desire to remain close to Jesus somewhat challenging. What they seek in terms of closeness is not to imitate Jesus' servanthood but to gain a privileged position. Jesus in speaking to his disciples, makes the distinction that their place in the community is not what rank or authority they have over others but in what service they can render in their midst. Closeness to Jesus comes from imitating the way that he lived his life for others.

Questions to consider after reading this Bible passages.

a) What do we learn about greatness and service from Jesus' teachings? b) What would be your definition of greatness? c) What do you think Jesus means when he says that those who wish to be first must serve others? d) Who are examples of "servant leaders" in your life and experience and what have you learned from them about service and greatness?

Additional Scripture Readings: Job 38: 1-7, 34-41, Psalm 104:1-9, 24, 35 and Hebrews 5: 1-10

Where do you struggle with seeking privilege of position above the possibility of serving? How can you open up more to awe and wonder? What transformations might Jesus' words about greatness and service work in your congregation?

2) Prayer: God of mystery and majesty, you call all life into being. Call us to the places where we may best serve you. Call us to the service where we may follow you most closely. Amen

Revenue is down by \$15,861. Receipts are primarily dragging in envelope givings. Rentals are slowing returning and we will have a month or so continuing Government Subsides, but at a much reduced rate. In person envelope givings, e-transfers, mail offerings, and drop-offs are required to close the budget gap in revenues.

- Have you come in close contact with a person with symptoms of COVID-19 or who has come in close contact of a confirmed case COVID-19, in the past 14 days?
- Are you awaiting test results for COVID-19?
- Have you travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days or been in contact with someone who is sick and who has travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days?
