

## **Sunday School**

#### This Week's Sunday School Activities – Easter Sunday

The Easter story is the focus of the Christian faith. Our lives orbit the mystery of the empty tomb like the Earth around the sun. In the resurrection, the God of new things transforms reality and offers hope and life to all.

1) The Scripture Reading during the Service is Luke 24: 1-12. Upon going to the tomb on the first day of the week at early dawn, the women found the stone rolled away and there was no body. There were two men in very bright clothes who asked them "Why are you looking for the living among the dead?" They remembered the things that Jesus had taught them. Resurrection is not a matter of fear but of joyful faith.

Reflections on the readings from Easter Sunday

The message of resurrection joy enables those who know suffering to trust the mystery of the empty tomb and continue searching for evidence of life. With what words and actions might you witness to the mystery and joy of Jesus' resurrection?
