Sunday School

This Week's Sunday School Activities – Palm Sunday

Rejoicing and distress are the two things that people feel as Jesus is entering Jerusalem. A power is unleashed that continues to reverberate in our day and time. Rejoicing fades as the destructive powers of the cross have their way with Jesus. But joy exists in the crowd who greet Jesus. It is a joy that will not be crushed and becomes a source for all who take on the mind of Christ, even to this day.

1) The Scripture Reading during the Service is Luke 19: 28-40. As Jesus came to Bethpage and Bethany, at the mountain of Olivet, he sent two of his disciples into a nearby village to get a colt for him to ride into Jerusalem. When the disciples returned to Jesus, they placed their garments on the colt and Jesus sat upon it. They then threw more garments on the road. As Jesus moved along, the disciples rejoiced and praised God and Blessed the King who comes in the name of the Lord.

Additional Scripture Readings: Luke 22:14-23:56, Psalm 118:1-2,19-29, Luke 23:1-49, Isaiah 50: 4-9a, Psalm 31:9-16, Philippians 2: 5-11 Reflections on the readings from Palm Sunday

a) What brought the crowd together in these stories? b) Why do you think the crowd was excited? c) What do you wonder about when you hear these stories? d) Why do you think it is important for us to remember these stories?

As we follow Jesus into Jerusalem, we hear cries of anguish, trust, thanks and hope. Holy week invites us to own the fullness of life's experience. It takes courage and trust for Jesus and the disciples to enter Jerusalem and it takes courage and trust for us to face those things that cause harm or damage in our present day. How do your Holy Week traditions enable you to be honest, yet hopeful about the challenges that you face and the challenges that we face in our world?

2) Stay near to us O God, as we journey through this week. May remembrances of innocent suffering summon our words and deeds for justice today. May recollections of steadfast trust transform reluctance to walk by faith when sight is clouded. This we pray in the name of the Christ Jesus. Amen
