## Sunday School

### **This Week's Sunday School Activities – Seeing is Believing**

Although often referred to as low Sunday because it comes directly after the busy time of Easter week, this Sunday speaks of bold confidence. We hear the disciples proclaiming the risen Christ. God's loving ways cannot be contained and disrupt accepted norms, policies and practices of the time.

1) The Scripture Reading during the Service is John 20: 19-31- This reading reminds us how natural it is to let fear silence our voices and to hide behind locked doors. But again, the Holy Spirit is at work encouraging and challenging the disciples to be the witnesses that they have been called and empowered to be. We see this as they witness two of Jesus' resurrection appearances.

Additional Scripture Readings: Psalm 150, Acts 5: 27-32 and Revelation 1: 4-8

Reflections on the readings from this Sunday.

a) In what ways do the people in these readings inspire you? b) When do you think it is important for people to challenge the words or actions of their leaders? c) What gives you strength and courage to speak the truth about these situations?

In the midst of our own experiences of God, the church remains a community called to witness. In the repeated retelling of the story of resurrection, there is a time when fear moves over and confidence begins. May this confidence take us into our neighbourhoods to speak for justice and Love's agenda.

2) We are witnesses to your ways, O God. May we be inspired to speak for justice and love's agenda. When others would silence the voice of liberation, may we shout even louder.    Amen
