## Sunday School

**This Week's Sunday School Activities – Turning Point of Transformation**  
(A major change in our lives).

Christ's call to a transformed way of life often comes through those who suffer, the ones with whom Christ identifies. Listening to this call means seeing differently, recognizing ways we have been blind to what is going on and participation in the brokenness of the world. Listening to this call brings us to turning points where we can no longer ignore questions of oppression and brokenness, sustain the unsustainable, benefit from unjust systems and practices. Listening to Christ's call puts us on a journey of transformation.

1) The Scripture Reading during the Service is John 21: 1-19. In this reading, Peter reverses his threefold affirmation of love. Peter's transformation and restoration come through an encounter with the risen Christ. It is when Jesus tells the disciples to throw back into the water their empty net. The net then fills with fish, 153. The disciples then bring the net into shore and with bread that is there, they have breakfast with Jesus.

Additional Scripture Readings: Psalm 30, Acts 9: 1-6, (7-20) and Revelation 5: 11-14

Reflections on the readings from this Sunday.

a) What was the result of this encounter with the risen Christ? b) In what ways do you think the disciples were transformed as a result of their encounter? c) Which people or situations have challenged and transformed the way that you think and live? d) If you were to meet the risen Christ today, what might you be asked to do?

We are an Easter people. As people of faith, we are called to live by the gospel that accepts in grace and offers justice to those who have been unjust towards us. What trust is required from you to risk transformation, especially places of brokenness, so God's spirit may bring restoration, renewal, and transformation? What stories do you know that began personally, spread locally and became global?

2) We meet you O Christ in the ebb and flow of our lives. We hear you in another's words. We trust you in our need for healing. You are with us in times of life's turning. May your Spirit help us to hear your voice, trust your call and be with others in your way. Amen
